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Authorization to Apply for a Statewide Parks Program Grant for Tennyson Park Renovation [RESOLUTION NO. R-1819-57]

Executive Summary:

The Board of Directors will consider authorizing staff to submit a Statewide Parks Program - Round 3 application for the Tennyson Park Renovation project.

Financial Impact:

The Three-Year Capital Improvement Program CIP for the Tennyson Park Renovation project (CIP No. 2-097B). If awarded, the Statewide Park Program (SPP) grant would cover the a majority of the Tennyson Park Renovation development costs.

Staff Recommendation:

Authorize staff to submit a Statewide Parks Program - Round three (3) application for the Tennyson Park Renovation project.

Description of Item:

The Statewide Park Program - Round 3 (SPP), funded by the Parks and Water Bond Act (Proposition 68), is a competitive grant program to create new parks and new recreation opportunities in under-served communities across California. Grant applications are due on August 5, 2019, up to \$8.5 million can be submitted for each application and no matching funds are required.

The District has identified the Tennyson Park Renovation project (CIP No. 2-097B) as an eligible and competitive project for the SPP grant program due to it's location in an under-served community with inadequate access to parkland. A series of community meetings were held between May and June to develop a community-driven park design and to satisfy the community engagement requirements per the SPP grant guidelines.

If awarded, the SPP grant would cover the a majority of the Tennyson Park Renovation development costs.
